#### Important Information

The admission and lift ticket for pupils entitles them to ride the express lift and to enter the viewing platform at a height of 150m with a spectacular view over Vienna. For every 10 children, one accompanying adult is free of charge. The fares are only valid on weekdays.

The school group rate can only be granted if the school is billed in total.

### SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

### Information and regulatory requirements at the Danube Tower

Please note that these regulations are provisions from the notice on the operating facility permit and therefore unfortunately no exceptions can be made. The regulations serve to protect all visitors, especially in case of fire or disaster.



#### Dog owners

Dogs are not permitted on the Danube Tower in accordance by the authorities. Please leave your dog in suitable care on the ground. Guide dogs and assistance dogs are permitted.



In the express-lifts, only one person in a wheelchair per car may be transported to exit point 1 (viewing platform). Each wheelchair user must be accompanied by a person who can transport the wheelchair user if necessary. A maximum of 3 wheelchair users may be present in the tower's viewing platform at the same time. The stairs to the restaurant areas and the stairs to the indoor terrace cannot be used with wheelchairs.

Therefore, it is unfortunately not possible to visit these areas with a wheelchair. If you are able to walk short distances, our staff will be happy to show you the parking space provided for wheelchairs in the entrance area. The newly designed ground-floor areas - the Donaubräu, the Donaucafé and the shop - are of course barrier-free.

#### **Strollers**



Strollers are not allowed in the express lifts, therefore they cannot be taken to the viewing platform, the Turmcafé or the Turmrestaurant. Our staff at the ticket office will be happy to show you a place where you can leave your stroller.

#### No smoking on the Danube Tower

Smoking is officially prohibited throughout the tower.
